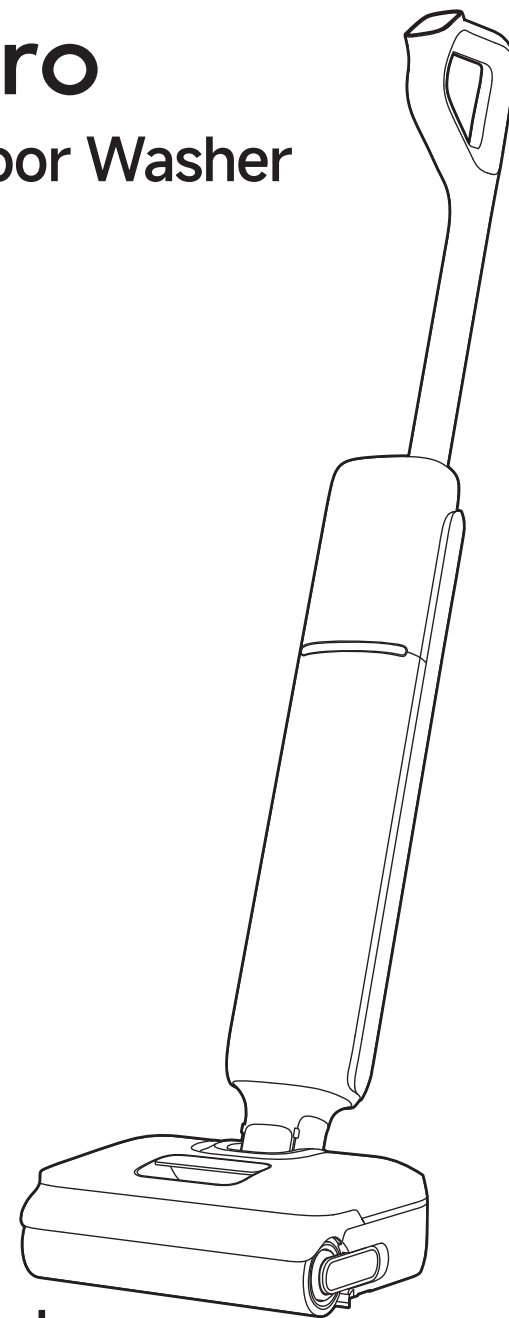

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Important Safety Instructions

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

When using an electrical appliance, basic precautions should always be followed, including the following:

READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE USING (THIS APPLIANCE). Failure to follow the warnings and instructions may result in electric shock, fire and/or serious injury.

WARNING- To reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, or injury:

- Do not use outdoors. Do not use on wet surfaces during charging.
- Do not allow to be used as a toy. Close attention is necessary when used by or near children, pets or plants.
- Use only as described in this manual. Use only manufacturer's recommended attachments.
- Do not use with damaged cord or plug. If appliance is not working as it should, has been dropped, damaged, left outdoors, or dropped into water, return it to a service center.
- Do not pull or carry by cord, use cord as a handle, close a door on cord, or pull cord around sharp edges or corners. Do not run appliance over cord. Keep cord away from heated surfaces.
- Do not unplug by pulling on cord. To unplug, grasp the plug, not the cord.
- Do not handle charging base, including charging base plug, and charging base terminals with wet hands.
- Do not put any object into openings. Do not use with any opening blocked; keep free of dust, lint, hair, and anything that may reduce air flow.
- Keep hair, loose clothing, fingers, and all parts of body away from openings and moving parts.
- Use extra care when cleaning on stairs.
- Do not use to pick up flammable or combustible liquids, such as gasoline, or use in areas where they may be present.
- Do not pick up anything that is burning or smoking, such as cigarettes, matches, or hot ashes.
- To reduce the risk of fire, do not use a flammable or combustible liquid to clean a floor.
- Do not use without water tank and/or filter in place.
- Prevent unintentional starting. Ensure the switch is in the off-position before picking up or carrying the appliance. Carrying the appliance with your finger on the switch or energizing appliance that has the switch on invites accidents.
- Recharge only with the charger specified by the manufacturer. A charger that is suitable for one type of battery pack may create a risk of fire when used with another battery pack.
- Use appliances only with specifically designated battery packs. Use of any other battery packs may create a risk of injury and fire.
- When battery pack is not in use, keep it away from other metal objects, like paper clips, coins, keys, nails, screws or other small metal objects, that can make a connection from one terminal to another. Shorting the battery terminals together may cause burns or a fire.

Important Safety Instructions

- Under abusive conditions, liquid may be ejected from the battery; avoid contact. If contact accidentally occurs, flush with water. If liquid contacts eyes, additionally seek medical help. Liquid ejected from the battery may cause irritation or burns.
- Do not use a battery pack or appliance that is damaged or modified. Damaged or modified battery packs may exhibit unpredictable behavior resulting in fire, explosion or risk of injury.
- Do not expose a battery pack or appliance to fire or excessive temperature. Exposure to fire or temperature above 130° C/266° F may cause explosion.
- Follow all charging instructions and do not charge the battery pack or appliance outside of the temperature range specified in the instructions. Charging improperly or at temperatures outside of the specified range may damage the battery and increase the risk of fire.
- Have servicing performed by a qualified repair person using only identical replacement parts. This will ensure that the safety of the appliance is maintained.
- Do not modify or attempt to repair the appliance or the battery pack except as indicated in the instructions for use and care.
- Always turn off this appliance before connecting or disconnecting motorized nozzle.
- Risk of injury. Brush may start unexpectedly. Keep the switch in off position before cleaning or servicing.
- Turn off all controls before unplugging.
- The appliance should be stored, used and charged only in the temperature range of 4° C/39.2° F~40° C/104° F.
- This appliance contains batteries that are non-replaceable.
- To reduce the risk of fire and electric shock due to internal component damage, use only dreamer cleaning fluid intended for use with this appliance. See the Cleaning Fluid section of this manual.

SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS

Household use only.

To reduce the risk of electric shock, the appliance has a polarized plug (one-blade is wider than the other). This-plug will fit in a polarized outlet-only one-way. If the plug does not fit fully in the outlet, reverse the plug. If it still does not fit, contact a qualified electrician-to install the proper outlet. Do not change the plug in any way.

Installation & Charging

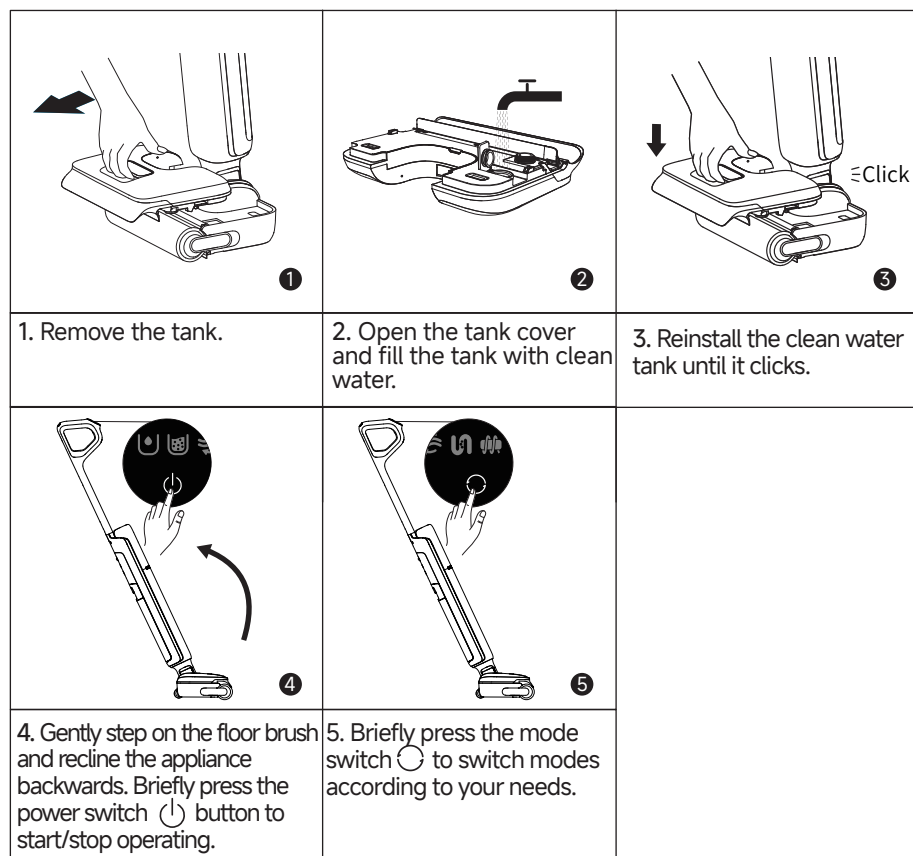
Fully charge the appliance before first use.



Note:

- If there is no operation within 10 minutes of being fully charged, the appliance will enter sleep mode. Please restart the appliance if you need to use it.
- To extend the battery life time, the battery keeps cooling down automatically after you have used the appliance for a long time.

Starting Cleaning



Note:

- Do not vacuum any foamy liquids.
- The appliance is suitable for cleaning floors, marble, tiles and other hard surfaces.
- When the appliance is in operation, do not lift it off the ground, move it or tilt it. Otherwise, the used water may flow into the motor.

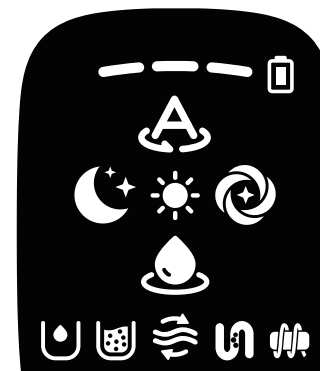
Add Cleaning Fluid

To reduce the risk of fire and electric shock due to internal component damage, use only Dreame Trading (Tianjin) Co., Ltd. AWH10 cleaning fluid intended for use with the appliance.

1. Remove the seal before use.
2. Measure the floor cleaner with the bottle cap (*approximately 10 ml/0.34 fl oz per cap).
3. Pour it into the clean water tank and gently shake to mix it evenly before use.

Note: Do not add any liquids other than the officially-approved cleaner. The cleaner can be available on the official online store. Refer to the cleaning solution label for specific usage instructions.

Display Screen



Smart Mode

The appliance will detect the stain level and intelligently adjust the suction power and water flow accordingly.



Quiet Mode

The appliance will maintain moderate suction power at a low noise level.



Turbo Mode

Maximum suction power and increased water flow for stubborn stains on hard floors.



Suction Mode

Suck up a large amount of water from the floor.

Self-Cleaning Mode



Dust Concentration Indicator / Self-Cleaning & Drying Progress Indicator / Charging Indicator

The color of the indicator changes with the amount of dirt in real time.



Insufficient water in the clean water tank

Fill the clean water tank.

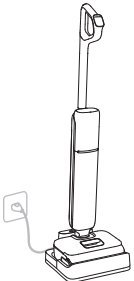
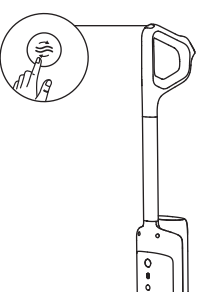
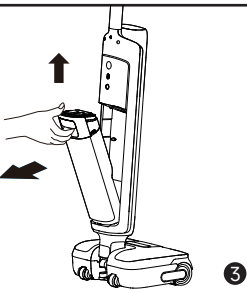
Battery Indicator

- Red: Battery level ≤ 20%

*Breathing light (Operating)

*Battery Indicator color cycles from green to yellow, orange, and red as charge decreases. Recharge when red.

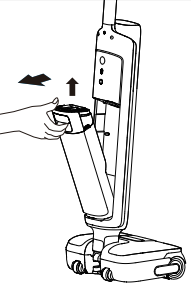
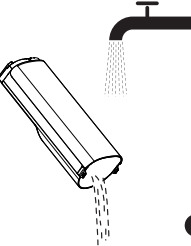
One-Press Self-Cleaning

		
1. Place the appliance back onto the base. Ensure that the water in the clean water tank is sufficient for self-cleaning.	2. Briefly press the self-cleaning button on the top of the handle to start/stop self-cleaning (Battery level $\geq 20\%$).	3. After self-cleaning is complete, the  will light up. Empty the used water tank promptly.

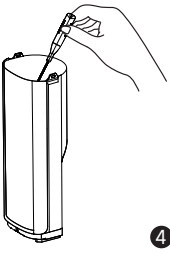
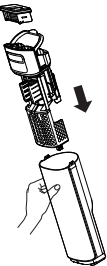
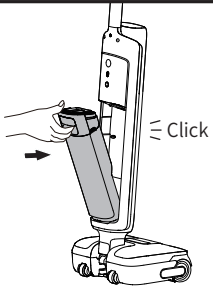
Note:

- After cleaning, promptly return the appliance to the base and ensure the clean water tank is sufficiently filled.
- To switch between Rapid Mode and Deep Mode, press the button again within 3 seconds of activation.
- After self-cleaning is complete, the appliance will automatically enter drying mode; please promptly empty the used water tank. To exit drying mode, press .
- Long-press for 3 seconds to activate Drying directly.

Emptying the Used Water Tank

		
1. Pull the used water tank handle to take out the tank.	2. Hold the used water tank cover and pull it out. Hold the filter and pull up to remove. Remove debris from filter.	3. Pour dirty water out and rinse tank with clean water.

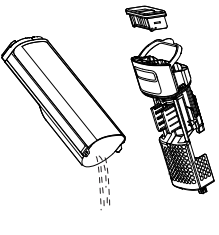
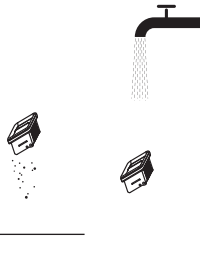
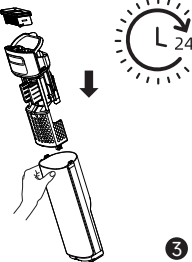

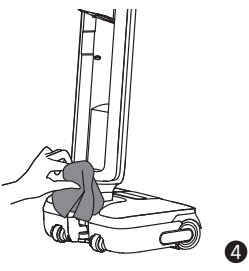
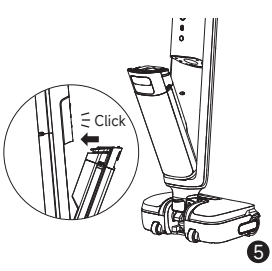
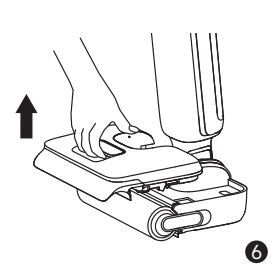
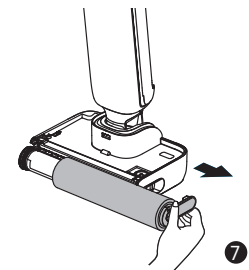
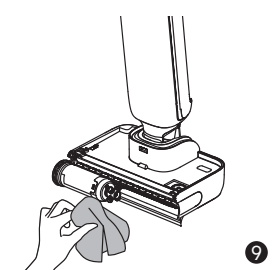
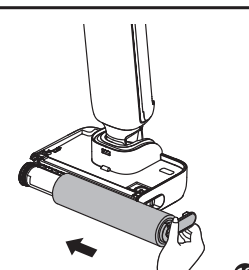
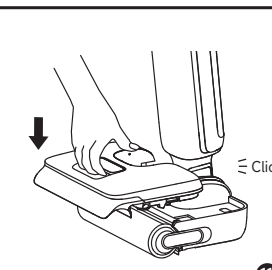
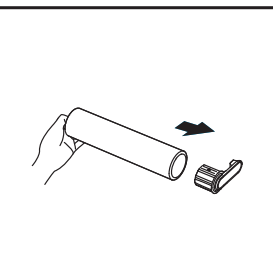
		
4. Use the provided cleaning brush to clean the inner walls of the tank.	5. After cleaning, insert filter into the used water tank cover, and insert used water tank cover into the tank.	6. Reinstall the Used Water Tank until you hear a click.

Care & Maintenance

Tips:

- Turn off the appliance before maintenance. Do not touch the power switch.
- Replace parts if needed. The parts must be replaced by those available from the manufacturer or its service agent.
- If the appliance is not used for an extended period, fully charge it, unplug the power plug, and store the appliance in a cool, low-humidity environment away from direct sunlight. To avoid over-discharge of the battery, charge the appliance at least once every 3 months.

		
1. Pour dirty water out, remove the filter, and rinse the tank and tank cover with clean water.	2. Gently knock off the floating dust on the filter surface. When the filter is dirty and needs washing, rinse it with water.	3. After fully drying the filter, reinstall it into the used water tank cover. Insert used water tank cover into the tank.

		
4. Gently wipe the tube with a wet cloth before use. Do not rinse the tube.	5. Insert bottom of tank into main body. Tilt tank towards main body until it clicks.	6. Remove the clean water tank.
		
7. Pull out the brush handle and remove the brush.	8. Remove any hair or debris tangled on the roller brush with the provided cleaning brush. Rinse the roller brush with clean water.	9. Wipe the suction inlet with a dry cloth or wet tissue. Do not rinse the brush assembly with water.
		
10. After fully drying the roller brush, hold the roller brush handle and reinstall it.	11. Reinstall the clean water tank until you hear a click.	* Remove the roller brush handle to replace it with a new roller brush, and press it firmly into place.

Note:

- Replacing the filter every 3 to 6 months is recommended.
- Clean as needed. Replacing the roller brush every 3 to 6 months is recommended.

Troubleshooting

If an error occurs, the appliance will stop working. Please refer to the following table for troubleshooting. If the problem persists, please contact customer service.

Error	Possible Cause	Solution
The appliance does not work	The appliance is out of battery or its battery level is low	Fully charge its battery before use
	The appliance is in the upright position	Recline the appliance backwards
	Blockage activated overheat protection mode	Clear the blockage and wait until the temperature returns normal
	The Used Water Tank is full	Empty the Used Water Tank
The appliance charges slowly	The temperature of the battery is too low or too high	Wait until the battery's temperature returns normal
	The filter is clogged	Cleaning the filter
The suction power of the appliance is weak	The suction inlet or tube is blocked by a foreign object	Clean the tube and the suction inlet
	There is too much used water in the Used Water Tank	Empty the Used Water Tank
The motor is making a strange noise	The suction inlet is blocked	Clear any blockage in the suction inlet
	The charging base cable is not plugged into the electrical outlet	Make sure the charging base cable is plugged in
The display screen does not light up while charging	The appliance is not placed onto the charging base properly	Make sure the appliance is placed onto the charging base properly
	The Clean Water Tank is not properly installed in place, or the water in the Clean Water Tank is insufficient	Reinstall or fill the Clean Water Tank
No water is coming out of the appliance	It takes 30 seconds to dampen the roller brush	Turn on the appliance and check again in 30 seconds

Troubleshooting

The vent leaks water	A collision or a sharp pull causes water to enter the motor	Move the appliance gently back and forth while it is turned on
	The filter is not completely dry after being cleaned	Dry the filter completely before use
Self-cleaning fails	The roller brush may be jammed by large debris	Open the roller brush cover to check and clean the roller brush
	The appliance is not placed onto the charging base properly	Make sure the appliance is being charged before self-cleaning
	Self-cleaning cannot be enabled if the battery level is lower than 20%	The self-cleaning function can only be enabled when the appliance is being charged and the battery level is more than 20%
	The Used Water Tank is not installed in place, or the Used Water Tank is full	Reinstall or empty the Used Water Tank
	The Clean Water Tank is not installed in place, or the water in the Clean Water Tank is insufficient	Reinstall or fill the Clean Water Tank

Error Prompts and Solutions

If the appliance is not working properly, the screen display will show an error message. Please refer to the troubleshooting table to find your solution.

Error Icon	Possible Cause	Solution
	Insufficient water.	Fill the clean water tank.
	The Used Water Tank is full.	Please clean the used water tank.
	Roller brush stuck.	Clean the roller brush.
	Blocked tube.	Refer to the Care & Maintenance section to clean the tube and dirt sensor.
	Brush roll and duct clogged with dirt.	Refer to the Maintenance & Care section to clean the ducts and the dirt sensor.
	Appliance malfunction	Restart the appliance for troubleshooting. If the problem persists, please contact customer service.

Battery Disposal and Removal

The built-in lithium-ion battery contains substances that are hazardous to the environment. Before disposing of the battery, make sure the battery is removed by qualified technicians and discarded at an appropriate recycling facility.

- the battery must be removed from the appliance before it is scrapped;
- the appliance must be disconnected from the supply mains when removing the battery;
- the battery is to be disposed of safely.

Removal Guide

1. Use tools to sequentially disassemble the main unit of the appliance and the power source components.
2. Disconnect the terminal connecting the battery to the mainboard.
3. Use tools to sequentially remove the screws securing the battery bracket, then pry open the bracket with a tool and remove the battery.
4. Disassembly should be performed by the manufacturer, an authorized service provider, or qualified professionals.

CAUTION:

- Before removing the battery, disconnect the power and run out the battery as much as possible.
- Unneeded batteries should be discarded at an appropriate recycling facility.
- Do not expose to high temperature environment to avoid risks of explosion.
- Under abusive conditions, liquid may be ejected from the battery. If contact occurs, flush with water and seek medical help.
